CAS Trip

Our recent **CAS trip to Chikkamagaluru** with 20 enthusiastic DP2 students, was an unforgettable experience filled with adventure, camaraderie, and **valuable life lessons**. Nestled in the lush greenery of the Western Ghats, Chikkamagaluru provided the perfect setting for students to engage in activities that enhanced their **teamwork**, **discipline**, **and appreciation for nature**. The experiences they gained during the trip—whether trekking through the hills, working together to solve challenges, or simply enjoying the beauty of nature—will leave a lasting impact on their character and outlook on life.

MYP 3 Activity

STRUCTURE OF THE EARTH AND PLATE TECTONICS, INDIVIDUALS AND SOCIETIES

To understand the causes of natural hazards, students of MYP 3 looked at the structure of the Earth and the plate tectonics. They demonstrated their understanding through activities.

In one activity they selected an object and explained how it represented the structure of the Earth. The selection was an **interesting mix of fruits** (mango, plum, peach, gooseberry, avocado, modified coconut, apple), food items (egg, layered mouse, chocolate) and the **upper arm of the body**.

In another activity they collaborated with the Science lab to represent Earth's mass and to observe the convection currents. Using materials of different density (water, oil and polystyrene), the students showed how much each layer represents in proportion to the Earth's mass and how the convection currents in the mantle cause the movement of the tectonic plates. I appreciate our Individuals and Societies Teacher Ms. Prasoona for her sincere efforts to help the students understand the concept clearly.

PYP 4 Math Activity

DISTANCES OF PLANETS FROM THE SUN

In our recent PYP 4 math activity, students explored the **concept of scaled** measurements by mapping out the distances of planets from the Sun. Using a given scale for each planet, learners measured the distance from the Sun and **calculated the exact distances** in astronomical units (AU).

This **hands-on experience** allowed students to gain a deeper understanding of astronomical distances and the vastness of our solar system, while also applying their math skills to real-world contexts.

Through this activity, they engaged in collaborative problem-solving and enhanced their ability to work with units of measurement. I congratulate the **teachers of grade 4** for designing and carrying out this activity.
