This hands-on exposure provided students with valuable insights into the practical applications of drone technology and its potential across different fields.

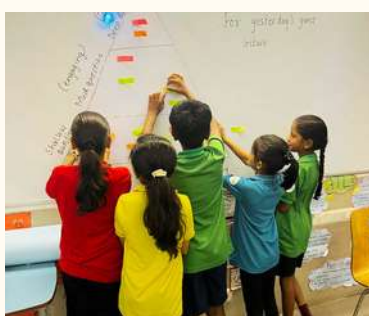
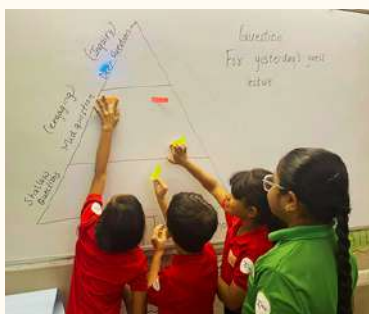
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## Celebrating Inquiry in Action!
