After two decades of building impactful products and teams at **Google, Meta,** and founding the Al startup Noosh.ai, Ms Anitha Mercy transitioned her career focus towards enabling students and professionals to thrive in the Al era.







This session at HUS was driven by a spirit of sharing, curiosity, and equipping the next generation with the tools and mindset needed to navigate the future of work. The goals of the session were

- 1. To **inspire curiosity around AI** and its implications for the future of work.
- 2. To equip **students with practical tools** and mindset shifts to help them take ownership of their paths in an Al driven world.

This was an interactive session blending storytelling, live AI demonstrations, and reflective engagement. The session was delivered with a giving mindset—not as a lecture, but as a collaborative, curiosity-sparking experience. It encouraged the students to see AI as an enabler and not as a threat, understand career paths are rarely linear and discover how values, creativity and tech can intersect meaningfully.
